A NOTE FROM PASTOR:

It is my hope that this newsletter will find each of you doing well and enjoying another beautiful Wisconsin summer.

If you have been to worship in the last month or so, you probably already know that we are focusing some attention on a project of the La Crosse Area Synod seeking to raise funds for and awareness about communities lacking access to safe, clean drinking water. This focus will peak for our congregation with two events, "Splash" – a water themed Vacation Bible School and an outdoor worship service at Riverside Park.

This summer's Vacation Bible School will be patterned similarly to last year's. We will once again be meeting evenings and serving an evening meal to the children. Many of you may remember a time when congregations would host a day camp styled VBS. I, myself attended one of these as a child and enjoyed it very much. I still remember some of the art projects and conversations I experienced. The format we have chosen for VBS allows us to support many of the things that children loved about those camp style opportunities: time with each other, indoor and outdoor games, dance and music, and crafts. The format also is a way in which congregations like Bethany are adapting to the changing needs of children and their families. This adaptation is a way in which Bethany models the virtue of hospitality for these younger people. One thing for certain has not changed. Bethany continues to care about the needs of the children God has sent to us. We are still in need of adults, middle school, and high school aged people to serve as extra hands and support Monday-Thursday evenings during VBS. Of course, if you know a person who is grade school aged whom you think would enjoy our VBS, please let them know that they are welcome. Plenty of extra VBS sign up forms are available at the church.

A water themed outdoor worship service will be held at the band shelter at Riverside Park in Mauston on Sunday, July 14th. This worship service will focus on some of the things we have learned together about the importance of water these past few months. There are some places to sit at Riverside Park, however I encourage you to bring a lawn chair to sit on. We will also have a potluck brunch following the worship service with time for fellowship and games. You are invited to bring a dish to pass and dishes and silverware to eat with. Please consider a lack of refrigeration and limited availability of electricity when planning what to bring with you to the park. Should the weather be poor that morning we will meet in the fellowship hall at Bethany so that we can worship surrounded by the theme and decorations associated with VBS. We will also be able to see the rain better through the windows.

Whether you are joining us for VBS or our outdoor worship this summer, I hope you have been blessed to see God at work in the world around you. God Bless, Pastor Joan Wittrock

June 2024 Council Highlights

- A thank you letter was received from the La Crosse Area Synod for the undesignated funds the Bethany congregation has donated.
- Kathy Marose reported that reusable tote bags are still available in the narthex for members to take one or more and use them wherever you shop. Also, jot down how members help care for God's creation and place it on the board in the narthex. Any donations received for the bags are designated to the "Water is Life" project.
- "Water is Life" project is to share information about the importance of water in our world. The
 Synod goal is to raise \$10 for each baptized member to be donated to ELCA World Hunger to
 provide clean drinking water to those in need. We continue with the "water question of the week"
 in the bulletin through July 14th. Pastor has designated VBS to focus on water, as well as the
 Worship in the Park service on July 14th at Riverside Park.
- Members of the congregation are asked to save 1 gal. plastic milk jugs and bring them to church by July 12th for part of the July 14th service. Anyone interested in volunteering to help with the worship service or games, please see Pastor or a member of the Committee.
- Faith Circle will again spearhead the school kits project. The specific needs are listed in the June Newsletter. Please shop accordingly.
- The committee will be hosting "Ice Cream Sundae" following the June 23rd service. Members are asked to bring their favorite toppings to share. A free will offering will be taken for the "Water is Life" project.
- The outside railing at the Fellowship Hall entrance has broken, so it has been removed until it can be replaced. Please use the main entrance as appropriate for safety.
- Watch the August-September newsletters for more information on the upcoming "Films with Friends" group, "Yesterday's Youth" at Sugar Creek, and "Christmas in the Dells" on November 3rd.

Dick Pirwitz reported on Synod Assembly:

- Synod Budget Resolution: The synod has been giving 46% of their income to the Churchwide ELCA.
 Beginning in February 2025, this will be reduced to 30%. At the end of their fiscal year, they will give from their net income up to the goal of 46% to Churchwide. Note: We give \$500/month to the Synod.
- Care of God's Creation: Congregations are asked to create a Creation Care Team and do tangible
 acts, selecting specific measures to care for creation. Our team is the Mission Committee and our
 members.
- A Resolution passed that urges the Synod, congregations, and individuals to support state and federal legislators to get an amendment to the U.S. Constitution limiting political spending.
- Pastor Joan is currently working on recruiting enough help for VBS. She is still in need of the Wednesday evening meal and 2 projects (Tuesday), as well as some volunteers and extra hands to help out. The kids can arrive as early 4:00pm, the meal is at 5:00pm, done at 6:30pm.

June 2024 Finance and Property Meeting

The F & P Committee met on June 11, 2024. The Committee approved mission support of \$500 to the La Crosse Synod/ELCA, \$85 to Lutheran Social Services and \$85 to the Mauston Food Pantry. An additional \$190 in donations was also collected for the food pantry, making a total donation of \$275.

- Fundraising for the asbestos remediation and the audio system is slowing down and we are still several thousand dollars short of our goal. Please contribute if you can, and thank you to all of those who have contributed.
- The status of several other projects were discussed.
- The contractor mowing the Cemetery asked if there were rules regarding flowers on the ground at
 grave sites as this makes it difficult to trim around headstones properly. This was referred to the
 Cemetery Committee and for a response to the contractor. Persons placing flowers at the Cemetery
 are encourage to use Shepard hooks or something else to elevate plants off the ground so the headstones can be maintained properly. Thank you.

The next meeting is scheduled for July 9th.
