Discussed the possibility of developing a 10-year long range plan, as Bethany had done years ago. This would provide Bethany with a priority project list for maintaining a pathway as we move forward.

Change to Endowment Fund member restriction: Currently, members are limited to one 2-year term after which, they must be off the committee for a period of two years, then could be back on the ballot. The committee would like this to be changed to allow them to be re-elected every two years. Approved.

The Community Thanksgiving Eve service (Nov 27th at 7:00 p.m.) will be hosted by Bethany.

Poinsettias have been ordered, envelopes are available to purchase them in honor or memory of a loved one.

Bethany will be hosting the distribution site for the Mauston Area Ministerial Assn. Christmas baskets. Pastor will share further planning details from Pastor Anita with Kathy. Bethany members responded generously for Hurricane relief. A pickup load of items was delivered to the Methodist Church for transport to North Carolina. Bethany contributed \$100 to help cover their transport costs. Monetary contributions will be directed to the Pastor in NC to be used where needed most.

The Angel Tree will be set up very soon in the Narthex. Bethany has been assigned a family of 5 – parents and 3 young boys, to provide a blessed Christmas for this family. Members select an angel from the tree, which will contain all the information they need about the person and an item of want or need Christmas. Shop for gift, wrap it, fasten the angel on the top of the gift and place it under the angel tree no later than December 15th.

The Property and Finance Committee has reviewed bids on the fellowship hall carpeting replacement. They are recommending the purchase of carpet squares. This will be built into the budget as a capital expenditure and discuss it with the congregation at the January Annual Meeting.

Lynxx fiber optic cable is now installed! There are repeaters installed so we have service from the office to the balcony to the lounge!

Pastor's Report: Pastor Joan requested March 30, 2025, off as she is getting married that weekend. Council approved, but is checking the church constitution to see if prior approval was required of the Council to get married and we did not get a chance to debate whether the groom was worthy to be Pastor's husband. This will be added to old business at the next meeting.

### **November Finance and Property Meeting**

The F & P Committee met on November 12, 2024. The Committee approved mission support of \$1,000 to the La Crosse Synod/ELCA, \$85 to Lutheran Social Services and \$85 plus \$168 to the Mauston Food Pantry.

The committee reviewed the status of some of the projects. The parking lot has been painted and pavers have been purchased for the shed border.

The fire inspection was discussed. Items need to be removed from the electrical room next to the sacristy and the room with the water heater in the basement. The church also needs to install a Knoxbox near the entrance of the Church. This is a secure box that will contain an entrance key for firemen/first responders to use in case of an emergency. This is actually a city ordinance.

The committee is recommending the purchase of carpet squares to replace the old carpeting in the fellowship hall to the Church Council.

The committee discussed several other suggestions that had been made and will consider them in the future.

The committee reviewed the line items in the budget and made several adjustments. Gary will make the appropriate adjustments and finalize the 2025 budget for review at the December committee meeting. The budget will be reviewed with the Executive committee then presented to the congregation at the annual meeting.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, December 10th at 5:30 p.m.

### **Food Pantry News**

A huge "Thank you" to all our area churches for their support during the past year! So far this year we have served over 500 different families. Pantry Families served in Mauston School District for October was 233 which contained 298 adults 128 seniors and 138 children. Our numbers are steadily increasing and the cost of food we need to purchase to keep ahead of the need is also on the rise. We could not do this without your generous help. Please remember that November and December are the time your donations really shine to make sure we have enough in our budget to distribute the over 300,000# of food during the year. Our budget for the year is \$70,000 and it all comes from individuals, businesses, clubs, school children, services groups and churches and grants. We have no paid staff at all. We have between 40-50 people who volunteer at the pantry to make it work. However you have helped this past year - volunteering, donations, and prayers – please know it is greatly needed and appreciated.
