Community Sharing Pantry stats for 2024

We would like to give a special "Thank you" to all the people that have assisted the pantry during the past year. Donations of food, cash, and volunteers time is what makes this pantry run. Remember, we have no paid staff. All donations go directly into the food and building. The churches are our wonderful foundation that keeping this going. We hope you enjoyed the year-end CPR Holiday Train. It is always a great way to celebrate the year for us.

As with every other organization, numbers served are up and costs are up. We still are offering 2 weeks of groceries to our families. We cannot do this without your gracious assistance.

This past year we served 550 different families, which contained 249 seniors, 724 adults, and 388 children. This totaled <u>1,361 different</u> <u>people.</u> There were 54 single parent households. We had 142 new families that we have never served or have not seen in over 5 years. We gave 50 different people a taxi ride home with groceries - 154 rides in 12 months. We will have copies of the stat sheets available for you in case you are into numbers.

We do need people to pick up from Festival Food one morning a week. We also need people that could work one morning a week to help in the back with moving boxes and other foods. Please contact Kathy Green at 608-847-5454 and leave a message. I will call you back.
